Minutes of September 29, 2016 Meeting

The meeting was convened by Chair Dan Burr at 18:35 hours at the Law Enforcement Center 230 N. Main, Driggs, ID

Those present were Trustees Dan Burr, Sean Moulton, and Jack Liebenthal; Eastern Idaho Public Health Department Epidemiologist Ken Anderson, District Director Greg Adams and Allan Loe. County Commissioner Bill Leake was present and swore in Trustees Dan Burr and Sean Moulton for another term.

Agenda items

- Approve previous minutes. The minutes of the May 11, 2016 were approved unanimously.
- Claims review. No claims were presented.
- Tire Drive cost. The cost was \$361.00. There were less tires than for the previous drive, but still a good response. RAD recycling accidentally damaged a MAD sign, but did the work free.
- Public outreach options. The board consensus was for an active effort to inform the public, in that specific citizen questions are responded to but more general public knowledge of the activities would be helpful. Allen spoke to this at length. Specific actions discussed and endorsed included:
 - health fair participation
 - presentations in schools, particularly 3rd and 4th grade level as most effective
 - printed matter: general mosquito facts, MAD image information, grade school packet, adult level packet. Allen offered to furnish material for the grade school packet and Jack offered to write an adult level fact sheet.
 - Cooperation with Friends of the Teton River. Dan will pursue this.
- AMCA Meeting. Greg Adams and Glenn Moradian if he chooses, were authorized by motion to attend the next national meeting in San Diego.
- Budget: Current expenditures and budget amounts were presented as attached and discussed.
